Dr. Rebecca Reesman is a project engineer in the National Security Space Programs, Policy, and Oversight division at The Aerospace Corporation where she provides support to the analysis branch of the Air Staff. She also supports Aerospace's Center for Space Policy and Strategy, covering rendezvous and proximity operations such as the emerging on-orbit servicing market.

Before joining Aerospace in 2017, Reesman was an American Institute of Physics Congressional Fellow handling space, cybersecurity, and other technical issues for a member of Congress. Prior to the fellowship, she was a research scientist at the Center for Naval Analysis, providing technical and analytical support to the Department of Defense, with a particular focus on developing and executing wargames.
